

## TAMC CONE ZONE REPORT

ROAD AND LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR DECEMBER 25 –  
DECEMBER 31

MONTEREY COUNTY – Here are the major scheduled road and lane closures for Monterey County from **Sunday, December 25 through Saturday, December 31, 2016** – **newest information is in red**. Please keep in mind that construction work is weather-dependent.

### **Holman Highway 68 Roundabout: December 27 – December 30**

- Daytime work continues off of the roadway.
- No nighttime is currently scheduled.
- Sign up to receive text message alerts for the Holman highway 68 Roundabout by texting **68roundabout** to 888777.

### **Highway 1 – Big Sur: December 27 – December 30**

- Daytime utility work along Highway 1 between Pfeiffer Burns State Park and Anderson Canyon Bridge from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

### **Highway 1 – Monterey to Marina: 27 – December 30**

- Nighttime grinding along Highway 1 between Sloat Avenue and Lake Drive from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

### **Highway 1 –Marina: 27 – December 29**

- Daytime traffic signal work will result in the closure of the Southbound Highway 1 off-ramp to Imjin Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

### **Highway 68 – Spreckels to Toro Park: 27 – December 30**

- Daytime bridge and sign work along eastbound and westbound Highway 68 between Spreckels Boulevard and Toro Park from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

### **Highway 101 – Greenfield to Gonzales: 27 – December 30**

- Daytime and night time median barrier work, paving, drainage, and bridge work between Teague Avenue and Alta Street/Old Stage Road.
- Work will result in intermittent lane and ramp closures in both directions.
- Motorists can expect delays of approximately 20 minutes.

### **City of Marina – Del Monte Blvd. & Beach Road Improvement Project**

- There will be no Beach Road access west of Del Monte Blvd. (near the railroad track).
- West-bound traffic on Beach Road will be detoured to Reservation Road via Del Monte Blvd.
- North-South traffic on Del Monte Blvd. will be reduced to one lane for each direction within the project area.
- Please note all stop signs and warning signs posted.
