## **LANE CLOSURES ON HIGHWAY 25 FROM PAICINES TO PINNACLES NATIONAL PARK FOR PAVING NEXT WEEK**

SAN BENITO COUNTY – Caltrans maintenance crews will be patching potholes and spot paving along an eight-mile section of both northbound and southbound Highway 25 from the junction of Hwy. 146/25 to San Benito River Bridge, between Paicines and Pinnacles National Park, starting Monday, July 25 for one week, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork will consist of lane closures with reversing one-way traffic control with flaggers from 8:30 am to 2 pm each day. Motorists can expect delays not to exceed 10 minutes and work is expected to be completed by Friday, July 29.

The CHP will be on-site to assist with traffic control. An electronic message sign will be posted alerting motorists of this work, which is being done by our Hollister Maintenance crew. This roadwork is necessary for the preservation of the road and safety of the travelers.
