State Route 13/Ashby Avenue Construction Continues

Alameda County – Caltrans has begun roadway repair at various locations between San Pablo Avenue and Hiller Drive, as part of the roadway resurfacing project on State Route 13 (Ashby Avenue). The project began Monday, July 9 during the daytime hours of 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Nighttime work may consist of pothole repairs at the intersections of Ashby Avenue & Telegraph Avenue, and Ashby Avenue & Shattuck Avenue, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. All final striping for the project may be done during daytime and nighttime hours.

At least one lane in each direction on SR 13 will remain open, but cross streets may be closed as construction moves through the area. **Please follow detour signs and directions of flaggers, all “NO PARKING ZONE” signage and please observe the 25 mph speed limit posted along SR13.**

Below is the current construction schedule. It may be modified as necessary. If work is not completed on the scheduled date, it will be rescheduled for the next work day/night. This construction is also weather dependent.

July 11

Northbound SR13 (west direction), 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

- Hiller Drive to College Avenue
- College Avenue to Adeline Street

July 12

Night work at Telegraph Avenue, 8 p.m., to 6 a.m.

Night work at Shattuck Avenue, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and to take alternate routes. Please be alert for workers and “Slow for the Cone Zone.”
