## REVISED LETTER

TO: MPOs AND RTPAs,

The Division of Rail and Mass Transportation (DRMT) is pleased to announce the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2016 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 “call for projects” funded by the new Transportation Legislation, Fixing America’s Surface Transportation Act (FAST). Approximately \$20.4 million will be allocated to California to enhance public transportation in rural areas. This amount excludes the amount allowable for administration and Section 5311(f) discretionary funding. The apportionment amount is based on the 2010 decennial census and represents the full funding amount for FFY 2016. The amount allocated to each region and balance sheets including pre-award letters is attached.

For the 2016 application cycle, the DRMT is implementing the BlackCat web based electronic grants management system. The DRMT only will accept all section 5311, 5311(f) and Rural Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) applications through the new BlackCat system.

### **FTA Sections 5311, 5311 (f) and rural CMAQ applications are due by April 15, 2016.**

To access the BlackCat system, complete and submit your application, please use the confidential log in information that should be sent to you after the BlackCat training sessions. If you did not receive a log in, please contact the BlackCat Grants Support Center at 1-888-238-9707. We have a follow-up web training for those who were not able participate in the statewide training last week or have more questions on the BlackCat electronic grants management system.
